

**2018 Country Club Road Asphalt Overlay

The City of Fort Madison is requesting bids for the Asphalt Overlay of Country Club Road. Attached is a map of the area. The final proposal must be turned in to the City Clerk and clearly marked "**2018 COUNTRY CLUB ROAD ASPHALT**" by **June 15, 2018 by 3:00pm** at 811 Avenue E, Fort Madison, Iowa 52627. All work must be completed by August 3, 2018. The following items will be minimum requirements. If you have any questions, please call Public Works Director Larry Driscoll at 319-372-7700, ext. 204. The City of Fort Madison reserves the right to waive all or any price quotes due to technicalities and accept or reject any or all due to past workmanship or pricing. Public Works Director will be available for tour and questions until June 14, 2018.

Bids should include all materials, labor, taxes, clean-up, ROW of cleanup and seeding, placing good dirt behind the curb line, equipment and transportation for proper execution and completion of all work. You must receive a tax-exempt certification through City Hall one week prior to the start of the project, no exceptions. You may contact the City Clerk Melinda Blind from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Monday through Friday for this item.

The City of Fort Madison will have all the grinding of the old road surface completed along with new road rock spread out on the street surface. The contractor will complete finish grade, roll test with Director and place 3" of asphalt but must be completed in 1.5" lifts with tack coat. All shoulder work and cleanup will be completed by the contractor. The City of Fort Madison will furnish all rock and a dump location if notified within 48 hours. All approach's must carry out and into the next intersection and meet up with new and existing asphalt.

The contractor will be responsible for adjusting any fixture that is in the street area. Each fixture will have a concrete circle around the entire fixture at least 6" wide from the edge of the fixture, please include in your bid.

The contractor will give a 2-year warranty on road surface. The warranty will be for cracking, splitting, or any defect that shows up due to poor workmanship or mix in the road surface within 2 years of being completed.

The contractor will submit a Certificate of Insurance with all proposals. The contractor will have until **August 3, 2018 by 3:00pm** to complete the work. The contractor must make contact with the Fort Madison School District, business owners in the area and the City of Fort Madison 48 hours before road work is started. The contractor is responsible for all signage and traffic control.
